RE: Idaho EDI Claims Release 3.0 Information Update

To All Idaho Workers' Compensation Carriers, Claims Administrators, and Self-Insured Employers:

This correspondence is to provide you with an update on the implementation of Idaho EDI Claims Release 3.0 for First Report of Injury (FROI) and Subsequent Report of Injury (SROI) forms. As you are aware, the 2016 Idaho Legislature approved amendments to IDAPA 17.02.06 and 17.02.07 that mandate the submission of workers' compensation claims information to be reported electronically to the Commission effective July 1, 2017.

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued May 13, 2016, for the procurement of a vendor to assist with the transmission of electronic data between Idaho Workers' Compensation Carriers, Third Party Claims Administrators, Self-Insured Employers and the Commission.

ISO's Workers Compensation Solutions division has been selected to assist the Idaho Industrial Commission claims with the implementation of this data collection program. ISO will manage the technical aspects of data submittal, be your main contact for implementation, technical requirements, and other questions you may have. In the near future, you can expect to hear from ISO directly about Claims EDI Reporting.
