**ORDER DENYING

On November 7, 2006, Claimant filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Commission's October 20, 2006, decision in the above-referenced case. Claimant contends that the Commission overlooked/ignored important evidence that is pivotal to the outcome of her case. Defendants respond that Claimant's arguments are without merit and, therefore, the Commission's prior Order should not be overturned.

The Commission is not persuaded by Claimant's arguments. Her motion amounts to little more than a request to reweigh the evidence. The testimony and evidence of the various doctors was carefully examined and weighed together with other aspects of the record prior to the Commission rendering its original decision. The Commission's decision is fully supported by the record.

Accordingly, Claimant's Motion for Reconsideration should be, and is hereby, DENIED.
