

Commission's April 24 Order was May 14, 2007. Claimant's May 24 filing was 10 days late. Therefore, the contents of Claimant's subsequent letter will not be considered.

After considering the contents of Claimant's May 10 filing, the Commission is not persuaded by his arguments. Claimant's motion amounts to little more than a request to reweigh the evidence. The testimony and evidence was carefully examined and weighed prior to the Commission rendering its original decision. Claimant failed to present medical evidence supporting his contentions. The Commission's decision is fully supported by the record.

Accordingly, Claimant's Motion for Reconsideration should be, and is hereby, DENIED.
