ORDER RESCINDING EMERGENCY
ORDERS

ORDER
March 29, 2023

The Idaho Industrial Commission has previously issued a series of emergency orders intended to address the substantial health and safety risks faced by the public accessing the Commission, and participants in Commission proceedings caused by the community spread of the coronavirus. The most recent such emergency order was entered by the Commission on June 9, 2021.


Since no counties in Idaho are currently subject to crisis standards of care and incident rates are generally lower across the state, the Commission deems it appropriate to rescind the emergency order, except that the revisions to the Judicial Rules of Practice and Procedure (JRP) and the Rules of Appellate Practice and Procedure (RAPP) providing for e-filing shall remain in effect. Further, Referees shall continue to have discretion to hold hearings remotely, with the agreement of the parties.


In accordance with the foregoing, the Commission hereby ORDERS that the Commission's June 9, 2021 Order RE: Idaho Industrial Commission Response to COVID-19 Emergency shall be rescinded effective **March 29, 2023**.
