RE: Compliance with Mandatory Implementation of Idaho EDI Claims Release 3.0


To All Idaho Workers' Compensation Authorized Carriers:

On February 1, 2017, the Industrial Commission began accepting trading partner registrations for the upcoming mandatory implementation of EDI Claims Release 3.0. The deadline for registration was March 15, 2017. Nevertheless, multiple authorized Idaho workers' compensation carriers have neither registered as an Idaho EDI Claims Release 3.0 trading partner nor initiated the required testing prior to the mandatory implementation date.

Effective November 4, 2017, First Reports of Injury (FROI) will only be accepted via EDI Claims Release 3.0. Subsequent Reports of Injury (SROI) for claims filed on or after this date must also be submitted via EDI. On this date, insurance carriers that have not registered as a trading partner will be considered out of compliance with the requirements for the proper reporting of injuries set forth in Idaho Code §72-602, and prompt claims adjusting as set forth in Idaho Code 72-304 and IDAPA 17.02.10.051.

Any carrier deemed to be noncompliant on November 4, 2017, may be required to appear before the Commission to show cause why its authority to write workers' compensation insurance in the State of Idaho should not be withdrawn in accordance with Idaho Code §72-301(5).

Workers' compensation carriers who have not yet registered are strongly advised to register as an EDI trading partner immediately at <https://iicedi.info/> to avoid adverse consequences.
